#### Advocacy





# Results from our programs.






### THESE PROGRAMS HAVE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING FOR THE CREW OF OUR INDUSTRY:

- Free access to mental health training
- Free access to advice on;
  - Financial management,
  - Managing stress and navigating conflict in the work place
  - Self Care
- Provided social gatherings for crew to bond and network outside of the work environment
- Support Act provides direct financial support for crew members experiencing financial hardship' with our assistance

### What does 2023 look like so far?

CrewCare has amassed a network and social media presence of over 17,000 and continuing to grow throughout this year. 2023 has seen some big changes in CrewCare with a new Chairman and 5 new members joining the board. There has also been a restructure within the board itself with new committees being formed and some older ones merged. These are the key aims CrewCare has for 2023....



Re-engage with current members and remind them of the programs and support available to them via CrewCare.

Increase members throughout Australia with a industry wide 'marketing' campaign and possibly run a single CrewCare Membership Drive Day.

A key focus here will be to communicate that CrewCare is for ALL CREW in the music industry no matter what field you work in.

Ensure there are social events in all states to build the CrewCare community.

Continue to bring new people into the industry via continued growth in education via scholarships and/or industry awareness programs.

Develop deeper engagement with the industry as a whole to continue the aims of CrewCare, this is where you come in.
